Reference to the above, Written examination for filling up of posts of Assistant Station Master in PB1 Rs.5200-20200+GP 2800/- against General Department Competitive Examination (GDCE) in SWR was conducted on 17-04-2016 (Sunday) at Hubli, Bangalore & Mysore centers.

As a next process of selection as indicated at Para 12.1 of the Notification, the candidates, who have secured qualifying marks in the written examination are to be subjected for Psycho/Aptitude Test as a pre-requisite.

The candidates called for the Psycho/Aptitude Test will be at the ratio of 1:5 from amongst those secured qualifying marks in the written examination held on 17.04.2016. The above ratio is based on the communal break-up of the vacancies as notified in the notification and about 356 candidates are eligible to be subjected for the said test.

Accordingly, the candidates are hereby alerted to be in readiness to attend the Psycho/Aptitude Test scheduled to be conducted from 22.06.2016 (02 Sessions) to 23.06.2016 (one session) at Railway Officers Club, Opp. DRM's Office, St.Andrews Church Road, Gadag Road, Hubli-580 020.

The candidates may verify their status of eligibility/ineligibility and the date to appear for Psycho/Aptitude Test by entering their **Roll No and Date of Birth** in the RRC website www.rrchubli.in. The eligible candidates may download the call letter from the RRC website.

It may be noted that, call Letters will not be sent to the eligible candidates through post. The Call Letters are downloadable and the eligible candidates may download the same through website of RRC, Hubli i.e. www.rrchubli.in. The downloading of Call Letters will be Open from 10/06/2016 onwards. The facility of downloading Call Letters will be closed at 23.59 hours on21/06/2016.

The candidates should take the hard copy of the downloaded Call Letters and present the same before the concerned authorities during the examination; failing which such candidates will not be allowed for writing the examination.

It may please be instructed to concerned Supervisors that, they should relieve the candidates on production of call letters duly issuing passes to the candidates for attending the Written Examination.
