- ii) A No-Objection Certificate from your present employer, if you are working in a Central Government/State Government/Public Sector Undertaking/Autonomous Body in case your application was not forwarded through proper channel. Without No-Objection certificate you will not be permitted to attend the Interview.

7. You will be admitted for Trade Test & Interview, only subject to the production of above Certificates in Original for verification. Candidates who do not produce the above Certificates will not be allowed for trade test & interview under any circumstances. You are also requested to bring a set of copies of all certificates mentioned in point 6.(i) above positively.

8. Since DAE installations are declared as prohibited area, you are required to bring any of the following documents in original along with you for entering the IGCAR Campus:

- ii. Passport.
- iii. Voter Identity Card.
- iv. PAN Card or Photo Identity Card issued by Educational Institution / any other Organisation.
