ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED DURING DOCUMENT VERIFICATION:

- 1) Original Matric or equivalent certificate indicating date of birth
- 2) ORIGINAL QUALIFICATION CERTIFICATES AS PER CEN 04/2014:
 - a) In case of Degree ORIGINAL Convocation Certificate OR ORIGINAL Provisional Degree Certificate along with all years or all semesters marks cards
 - b) LATEST ORIGINAL Diploma/NTC in Health/Sanitary Inspector
- 3) ORIGINAL of the SC/ST certificate uploaded in the online application. If the original of the community certificate enclosed to the application is not available, A certified true copy from the same issuing authority with seal and signature of the certificate issuing authority may be produced along with a LATEST SC/ST CERTIFICATE. Please note that the community (viz. SC or ST) should be specifically indicated in the caste certificate in addition to the name of the caste to which the candidate belongs.
- 4) Latest OBC Certificate in the prescribed format (wherever applicable), obtained after October 2014.
- 5) NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE from Competent Authority in case of serving Railway/Government Employees with full service particulars
- 6) ORIGINAL Discharge Certificate, Ex-Servicemen Book and Identity card in case of Ex-Servicemen candidates.
- 7) Candidates of minority communities who have claimed waiver of examination fee should furnish minority community declaration affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper that he/she belongs to any of the minority community notified by the Central Government.

IMPORTANT

IN ALL THE DOCUMENTS, CANDIDATE'S AND FATHER'S NAME SHOULD BE AS PER THE ONE APPEARING IN THE MATRIC CERTIFICATE.

- 8) If there is any variation in candidate's name or father's name in the educational certificates, the certificates have to be corrected and properly attested by the concerned authority OR an affidavit to that effect is to be produced.
- 9) If there is any variation in candidate's name or father's name in the Caste Certificate, a fresh certificate in the prescribed format with proper names is to be produced in original.
- 10) One set of SELF ATTESTED photocopy of all the above said certificates applicable to the candidate alongwith passport size photograph.
