INSTRUCTIONS

**[Interview for the posts of Scientist / Senior Scientist (Post Codes. S-1 & S-2)
advertised vide Advt.No.2/2015]**

1. Candidates shall bring any one of the original photo identity proofs among Aadhar Card, Driving License, Passport, Voter Id Card and PAN Card or any other Government issued ID proof. The candidates coming without photo identity proof will not be permitted to appear for the Interview.
2. Only outstation candidates (within India) called and found eligible for interview will be paid to and fro single sleeper class rail fare from the actual place of undertaking the journey or from the normal place of their residence whichever is nearer to the **Secunderabad Railway Station** on production of Rail Tickets/Rail Ticket Numbers or any other proof of journey. For road journeys between stations not connected by rail, the actual bus fare or road mileage at the lowest rate as admissible under rules, will be reimbursed, on production of documentary proof (bus tickets) and provided that the distance covered by road is more than 20 miles each way.
3. **Candidates in Annexure-I should report at 8.30 A.M. at the venue.**
4. **Candidate must make it sure that he / she satisfies all the eligibility criteria and possesses related certificate (s) as on prescribed last date of receipt of application, before planning to appear for interview.**
5. Candidates are required to bring the following Certificates in Original for verification and also one set of self-attested photocopies thereof at the time of Interview:
 - a) Matriculation certificate / mark sheet for date of birth. No other document relating to age will be accepted. Date of Birth mentioned in application is final. No subsequent request for change of date of birth will be considered or granted.
 - b) All certificates of educational qualifications along with mark sheets of all the academic years.
 - c) Experience certificates, if any.
 - d) Certificate in support of claim to belong to Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribes / Other Backward Classes (Non-Creamy Layer) / PWD [wherever applicable] in the format (s) prescribed in connection with employment in Govt. of India.
 - e) An Affidavit, if there is difference in either name/father's name or spelling of name/father's name in all the Certificates and application form.
 - f) No Objection Certificate – in case employed in CSIR Labs / Government Department / Autonomous Bodies / Public Sector Undertakings

Note: Candidates are required to bring an Experience Certificate (with minimum 2 years research experience in the related area) at the time of Interview to consider his/her candidature for the position of Senior Scientist, subject to other eligibility conditions.

6. In respect of equivalent clause in Essential Qualifications, if a candidate is claiming a particular qualification as equivalent qualification as per the requirement of advertisement, then the candidate is required to produce order/letter in this regard, indicating the Authority (with number and date) under which it has been so treated, otherwise his / her candidature is liable to be rejected.
7. The date for determining qualifications and/or experience shall be the closing date prescribed for submission of online application.
8. In case of claims regarding change in name after matriculation on marriage or remarriage, divorce etc., the following documents shall be submitted:

 - d) In other circumstances for change of name for both male and female – Deed Poll / Affidavit duly sworn before the Oath Commissioner and paper cutting of two leading daily newspaper in original (one daily newspaper should be at the area of applicants permanent and present or nearby area) and Gazette Notification.
9. Candidates claiming age-relaxation as widow should produce Death Certificate of her husband together with the Affidavit that she has not remarried since. Divorced Women or Women judicially separated from their husbands, should produce a certified copy of the judgment/decree of the appropriate court to prove the fact of divorce or judicial separation as the case may be and the Divorcee should produce along with an Affidavit that she has not remarried since.
10. Candidates claiming age-relaxation as a domicile of the state of Jammu and Kashmir should produce a certificate from the District Magistrate in the State of Jammu and Kashmir within whose jurisdiction he / she had ordinarily resided or from any other authority designated in that behalf by the Government of Jammu & Kashmir to the effect that he / she had ordinarily been domiciled in the State of Jammu and Kashmir during the period from 1st January 1980 to 31st day of December 1989.

11. Upper age limit is relaxable up to five years for the regular employees working in Government Departments, autonomous bodies and public sector undertakings. The candidate has to produce the service certificate, issued after the date of advertisement from his / her employer on Office's letter head, showing the details of the total service rendered in regular capacity as on the last date of submission of online application for the post.

PLAN OF INTERVIEW

Presentation

1. The Candidate should plan a focused presentation of maximum 10 minutes. The presentation should highlight;
 - Responsibilities assigned to him / her during past
 - Own contributions in relevant area (without spending time on presenting work with negligible role)
 - Examples of innovations and problem solving skills demonstrated in relevant area
 - Future plan of work.
2. The presentation should be in MS Power Point and copied on a blank CD/USB drive without any other files except the presentation and its supporting files, ensuring a virus free media. The same may please be first discussed well in advance on the day of interview with the authorized persons at the venue. The number of slides may be kept to the minimum.
3. The Candidates appearing before the Selection Committee should bring necessary documents in support of the scientific contributions / achievements.
4. Hindi may be used as medium of conversation. The research papers written may also be presented.

Discussion

1. During the discussion, which will follow the presentation by the Candidates, the Selection Committee will be trying to ascertain;
 - Whether the Candidate understands the scientific principles in general and scientific principles pertaining to his / her area of work he or she is engaged in, in particular.
 - Whether the Candidate has introduced some innovative thinking in the work.
 - Awareness of the state-of-art in the area of work
 - Potential of taking on responsibilities when appointed, ability to work harmoniously in a team besides qualities of leadership and project management skills.
2. It is also expected that the candidate would have a ready answer to all questions asked, but the reaction to question and the ability to work out an answer in a logical manner would demonstrate the scientific thought process.

**The normal place of posting is CSIR-NGRI at Hyderabad. However, apart from the above job requirement a selected candidate, on the discretion of the Competent Authority, may be posted to work in any Section / Division and at any place in India.

1. Benefits under Council Service:

- a) These posts carry usual allowances i.e. Dearness Allowance (DA), House Rent Allowance (HRA), Transport Allowance (TA) etc. as admissible to the Central Government employees and as made applicable to CSIR. Council employees are also eligible for accommodation of their entitled type as per CSIR Allotment Rules depending on availability in which case HRA will not be admissible.
- b) In addition to the emoluments, benefits such as reimbursement of Medical Expenses, Leave Travel Concession, Conveyance Advance and House Building Advance are available, as per rules of CSIR.
- c) Scientists (Post Code. S-1 and S-2) are entitled for Career Advancement on the basis of Flexible Complementary Scheme of CSIR and also eligible for two additional increments (without DA) and professional update allowance of Rs.10,000/- per annum.
- d) All New Entrants will be governed by the "New Pension Scheme" based on defined Contributions for new entrants recruited from Central Government Services on or after 01-01-2004, as adopted by CSIR for its employees. However, persons selected from other Government Departments/Autonomous Bodies/Public Sector Undertakings/Central Universities having Pension Scheme on Govt. of India pattern will continue to be governed by the existing Pension Scheme i.e. CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972.

2. General conditions / information:

NOTE: The persons who have already applied against the post of Scientist (at Post Code No. SC-2) of CSIR-NGRI Advt. No.2/2013 need not to apply again for the post against Post Code S-2 of this advertisement provided they satisfied all the eligibility criteria as on the last date of online submission of application for CSIR-NGRI Advt. No.2/2013 i.e. as on 12.08.2013.

- a) The applicant must be a Citizen of India.
- b) All applicants must fulfil the essential requirements of the post and other conditions stipulated in the advertisement. They are advised to satisfy themselves before applying that they possess at least the essential qualifications laid down for various posts. No enquiry asking for advice as to eligibility will be entertained. The prescribed essential qualifications are the minimum and the mere possession of the same does not entitle candidates to be called for interview.
- c) The date for determining the upper age limit, qualifications and/or experience shall be the closing date prescribed for submission of Online application i.e. **24.07.2015 (Friday).**
- d) The period of experience in a discipline/area of work, wherever prescribed, shall be counted after the date of acquiring the minimum prescribed educational qualifications prescribed for that Grade/Post.
- e) Candidate must ensure that he/she possesses educational qualification/experience in the relevant area as required in the category/post, for which he/she is applying, on the last date of receipt of application.

- h) The posts carry usual allowances as admissible to Central Government employees as have been made applicable to CSIR employees.
- i) Deserving candidates may be considered for higher start of pay.
- j) Only outstation candidates called and found eligible for interview will be paid to and fro single second class rail fare from the actual place of undertaking the journey or from the normal place of their residence whichever is nearer to **Secunderabad Railway Station** on production of Rail Tickets/Rail Ticket Numbers or any other proof of journey.
- k) Any discrepancy found between the information given in application and as evident in original documents will make the candidate ineligible for appearing in interview. Such candidate will not be paid any fare.
- l) The number of vacancies indicated against each category is provisional and may vary at the time of selection.

3. Age Limit and Relaxations :

- a) The date for determining the age limit/experience/qualifications shall be the closing date prescribed for submission of Online applications is **24-07-2015 (Friday)**.
- b) The respective upper age limit is relaxable up to 05 years for SC/ST and 03 years for OBC (non-creamy layer) as per Government orders in force only in those cases where the posts are reserved for respective categories, on production of relevant certificate in the prescribed format signed by the specified authority at the time of interview.
- c) **Age relaxation to Persons With Disability (PWD):** Age relaxation of 5 years is allowed for the posts against Post Codes S-1, S-2, TA-1 & TA-2 (total 10 years for SCs / STs and 8 years for OBCs in respect of the posts reserved for them) and 10 years is allowed for the posts against Post Code T-1 (total 15 years for SCs / STs and 13 years for OBCs in respect of the posts reserved for them), in accordance with the relevant rules.

#[Note: The respective upper age limit as reflected against each post in the table is inclusive of the above two relaxation criteria.]

- d) The upper age limit is relaxable upto five years for the regular employees working in CSIR Laboratories /Institutes, Government Departments, autonomous bodies and public sector undertakings.

 - ii) In case of divorced Women and Women judicially separated from their husbands, a certified copy of the judgment/decreed of the appropriate Court to prove the fact of divorce or the judicial separation, as the case may be, with an Affidavit in respect of divorced Women and they have not remarried since.

- f) SC/ST/OBC (Non Creamy Layer)/PWD candidates are required to produce a copy of the certificate in the prescribed format signed by the specified authority at the time of interview. The OBC candidate should produce the certificate valid for appointment of posts under the Central Government.
- g) Relaxation in age, over and above the stipulated limit, educational qualification and/or experience may be considered in case of exceptionally meritorious candidates and if sufficient number of candidates possessing the requisite qualification and/or experience are not likely to be available to fill up the posts.
- h) Relaxation of five years will also be permissible to those who had ordinarily been domiciled in the Kashmir division of the state of Jammu and Kashmir during the period from 1-1-1980 to 31-12-1989 subject to production of relevant certificate from concerned authority.

4. Mode of Selection:

- a) Mere fulfilment of educational qualifications and experience does not entitle a candidate to be called for interview. The duly constituted Screening Committee will adopt its own criteria for short-listing the candidates. The candidate should therefore, mention in the application all the qualifications and experiences in the relevant area over and above the minimum prescribed qualification, supported with documents. Completion of Ph.D. degree will be reckoned from the date of issue of provisional certificate/notification.
- b) **In the event of number of applications being large, the NGRI-CSIR will adopt short listing criteria to restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable number by any or more of the following methods:**
 - i. On the basis of higher educational qualifications than the minimum prescribed in the advertisement
 - ii. On the basis of higher experience in the relevant field than the minimum prescribed in the advertisement
 - iii. By holding a written Test.
 - iv. Any other methodology as deemed fit by Screening Committee.
- c) In case a candidate is staying abroad, his/her candidature can be considered *in absentia* by the Selection Committee on his/her written request.
- d) For the posts against Post Codes. S-1 & S-2, the Selection Committee may choose to place the candidate in any of the Grade Pay within the Pay Band depending upon the performance of the candidate and subject to meeting the minimum eligibility criterion specified.

- c) The Online Application with necessary instructions / guidelines to fill, will be available on CSIR-NGRI website www.ngri.org.in (the related link **Opens on 29.06.2015 (Monday) from 09.30 a.m. and Closes on 24.07.2015 (Friday) at 06.00 p.m.**)
- d) There is no application fee for applying for any of the posts in this advertisement.
- e) Candidates should keep copy of the application print-out for record. Print-out of Application Form will not be available after **06.00 p.m. on 24.07.2015 (Friday).**
- f) Application once received, will not be allowed to be withdrawn.
