Terms and Conditions for Joining ICPR Junior Research Fellowship

1. The fellowship is a fulltime assignment. Hence, the Fellow is not supposed to be in any other assignment or employment during the 2 years period along with the fellowship. If any other employment is undertaken or the project under the fellowship is completed / abandoned / terminated within 2 Years period of the fellowship, the matter has to be informed to the ICPR by the fellow / the Concerned Supervisor / HOD and the Institution, so that the fellowship will be ended / discontinued forthwith.

2. An undertaking of the Fellow, countersigned by the supervisor and HOD, in a stamp paper of worth Rs. 10/- has to be furnished at the time of joining the fellowship, which should include the following:

(A) Declaration of Fellow's own identity with name, gender, date of birth, father's name and addresses, name of fellowship selected for at ICPR and title of the research topic.

(B) "I am not in any other assignment or employment at the time of joining the fellowship, and if I undertake any such assignment or submit the project in my research institution at any time during the 2 years period of the fellowship, I shall inform the Council the same for ending / discontinuing the fellowship forthwith."

(C) "I shall refund the entire amount of fellowship and contingency grant received till date, in the event of discontinuation / termination of the fellowship."

(D) "I shall abide by the terms and conditions of the fellowship and additions as well as modifications thereof. In case of non- compliance of terms and conditions, the Council may take action as it considers fit."

(E) "Legal dispute, if any, will be settled in the Court of Delhi."

3. During the tenure of the fellowship, two types of reports have to be submitted. (a) Monthly progress cum attendance report (MPAR) in prescribed format, at the end of every month, on the basis of which monthly payments will be released. Scanned copy of MPAR can be sent by email. (b) Six monthly progress report (SMPR) showing substantial academic progress along with the filled-in prescribed format at the end of six months (i.e., one installment period) on the basis of which, if the report is satisfactory, the next installment will be released.

In case articles published or seminars, conferences attended which is related to the fellowship project work during the term of fellowship, a due acknowledgement to ICPR must be made and the matter must be furnished with six monthly progress report. At the end of the 2 years term of the fellowship, if not before, the Fellow has to submit the final manuscript in a bound form, which must be of publishable standard.

If the progress reports are not submitted within maximum of 3 months of the due date and/or the report is not satisfactory, the fellowship will not be released. The fellowship will eventually be terminated. The amount released till then will be recovered from the Fellow.

4. The General and Junior Research Fellows are required to visit the Academic Centre at Lucknow for at least 2 weeks in the 2 years period of fellowship.

5. The Contingency amount will be paid for expenditure in respect of stationary, typing, printing, photocopying, books, journals and travel (up to 3rd AC rail fare for General and Junior Research Fellows) for attending the concerned seminar / conferences/ workshops. This will be released on the installment basis on production of statement of expenditure along with supporting bills / receipts / vouchers / tickets, etc., in original with self attestation and dates on back of each of them. Some amounts will be deducted from the contingency towards the life-subscription fee for the Council's journal, JICPR, in favor of the Fellow, provided the Fellow is not already a life member for the Journal.

6. The Fellowship amount would be transacted on pro-rata basis per month by money transfer through ECS, for which the Fellow has to furnish the account details along with a cancelled Banker's Cheque of the same account.

7. Within 5 years of acceptance of the fellowship, no other fellowship can be accepted from ICPR.

Documents to be furnished at the time of Accepting / Joining the Fellowship

1. Joining Report (bearing title of the research) along with a copy of Ph. D Registration, both to be authorized by Supervisor, HOD and Registrar / Equal Officer.

2. Undertaking in the stamp paper.

3. Details of bank account (preferably in Canara Bank) stating Account Holder's (the Fellow's) name in Bank account, Account No., IFSC Code of the Bank, Name of the bank, Branch and Address with Phone No.) and a cancelled Cheque from the same bank of the same account.

4. Last Salary Details, (Only for in-service Candidates for GF)

5. Consent letter from the Supervisor mentioning the title of the research and duly forwarded by HOD.

6. Acceptance letter from HOD stating that all facilities will be provided to the Fellow for the research under the ICPR fellowship.

7. Anticipated Expenditure for First Six months on which an advance Contingency will be released (For Rs.7,500/- for JRF and Rs. 10,000/- for GF). This may also include a statement of declaration and details of previous life-subscription of JICPR, if any.

8. An email ID, Contact Phone No. and Address for communication.

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Terms and Conditions for Joining ICPR Senior Fellowship

1. The fellowship is a fulltime assignment. Hence, the Fellow is not supposed to be in any other assignment or employment during the 2 years period along with the fellowship. If any other employment / engagement is undertaken or the project under the fellowship is completed within 2 Years period of the fellowship, the matter has to be informed to the ICPR by the fellow, so that the fellowship will be ended / discontinued forthwith.

2. An undertaking of the Fellow, in a stamp paper of worth Rs. 10/- has to be furnished at the time of joining the fellowship, which should include the following:

(A) Declaration of Fellow's own identity with name, gender, date of birth, father's name and addresses, name of fellowship selected for at ICPR and title of the research topic.

(B) "I am not in any other assignment or employment at the time of joining the fellowship, and if I undertake any such assignment or submit the project in my research institution at any time during the 2 years period of the fellowship, I shall inform the Council the same for ending / discontinuing the fellowship forthwith."

(C) "I shall refund the entire amount of fellowship and contingency grant received till date, in the event of discontinuation / termination of the fellowship."

In case articles published or seminars, conferences attended which is related to the fellowship project work during the term of fellowship, a due acknowledgement to ICPR must be made and the matter must be furnished with six monthly progress report. At the end of the 2 years term of the fellowship, if not before, the Fellow has to submit the final manuscript in a bound form, which must be of publishable standard.

If the progress reports are not submitted within maximum of 3 months of the due date and/or the report is not satisfactory, the fellowship will not be released. The fellowship will eventually be terminated. The amount released till then will be recovered from the Fellow.
