**Notes to the Statement of Cut-Off Marks:**

- As was declared in the Detailed Advertisement, the merit list has been prepared in order of the total marks obtained in written test and is subject to the candidates passing the medical fitness test and verification of their identity & eligibility.

- Further, as was declared in the Detailed Advertisement, if more than one candidate is placed at the cut-off point (without any rounding off) of the merit list, the candidate who is senior in age would be preferred. Accordingly, where more than one candidate was at the cut-off point in the merit list, the person senior in age has been placed at higher rank.
- Cut-off marks of Wait List may slightly vary if an expanded/supplementary Wait List is issued for any category due to rejections in medical fitness test or verification of identity and eligibility.
