Subject:- Junior Translators in (CSOLS) Examination 2012 – Declaration of final result - reg.

Staff Selection Commission conducted an open competitive examination for recruitment to the post of Junior Translators in CSOLS in various offices/departments under the Deptt. of Official Language on **18.11.2012**. The result of 832 candidates qualified in Paper-I for evaluation of Paper-II was declared on **1.1.2013**. Subsequently based on the marks obtained in Paper-II, **478** candidates were declared qualified for being called for interview.

2. Keeping in view the vacancy position, category-wise details of candidates declared qualified for appointment are as under:

(Note: In the notice, candidates were asked to fill up their preference for State/UTs also but the same were not considered for allocation since the vacancies were reported on All-India basis.

- 3. As per Notice of Examination, in cases where more than one candidate secure equal aggregate marks, tie is to be resolved by applying the following methods sequentially.
 - (1) By referring to the total marks in the written examination.
 - (2) By referring to marks in Paper-I of the written examination.
 - (3) Date of birth i.e. the candidate older in age gets preference.
 - (4) By referring to the alphabetical order of the names taking first name into consideration.

- 5. There are **16 candidates** whose candidature have been kept as **Provisional** by concerned regional offices but are also included in the Select List. Concerned RDs/DDs will be required to check the eligibility of such candidates thoroughly before their nomination.
- 6. The result is **purely provisional** and subject to candidates fulfilling all eligibility conditions prescribed in the notice of the said examination and also subject to, among other things, thorough verification of their identity with reference to their photographs, signatures, handwriting etc. on the application form, admission certificate etc. The candidatures of the candidates are liable to be cancelled by respective Regional/Deputy Directors in case of candidates found not fulfilling the eligibility conditions.
- 7. For candidates belonging to reserved categories for whom certain number of vacancies are reserved as per the policy of the Government, the category status is indicated against their roll numbers. It is important to note that some of these candidates have been declared qualified for the category mentioned against their roll numbers. If any candidate does not actually belong to the category mentioned against his/ her name, he/ she may not be eligible to be included in the list. It is, therefore, in the interest of the candidates concerned to immediately contact the respective Regional Offices of the Commission in all such cases where they do not belong to the category shown against their roll numbers.
