**JE(CIVIL & MECH) in CWC and JE(ELECT) in Deptt. of Posts Examination, 2011**  
**DECLARATION OF FINAL RESULT**

The Commission conducted the above mentioned examination on 01.05.2011 for recruitment to the post of J.E.(Civil & Mechanical) in the CWC and the post of J.E. (Electrical) in the Department of Post.

2. 15958 candidates appeared in the examination. As per the cut-off approved by Commission in Paper-I, 336 candidates in Civil, 160 candidates in Mechanical and 56 candidates in Electrical qualified for evaluation of Paper-II. As per the cut-off approved by Commission in paper-I + II, 317 candidates in Civil, 112 candidates in Mechanical and 41 candidates in Electrical qualified for interview.

4. Following is criteria adopted for RESOLUTION OF TIE CASES :-

In case where more than one candidate secure the equal aggregate marks, the tie will be resolved by applying the following methods one after another :-

- (1) By referring to the marks in the written Test.
- (2) By referring to marks in Paper-I of the written Test.
- (3) Date of birth i.e. the candidate older in age gets preference.
- (4) By referring to the alphabetical order of the names taking first name into consideration.

8. The category status in respect of the candidates belonging to reserve categories has been indicated along with their roll numbers. It is important for such candidates to note that they have been declared qualified only for the category mentioned against their Roll Numbers. If any candidate does not actually belong to the category mentioned against his Roll Number or his roll number and name do not match, he may not be eligible to be included in the list. It is, therefore, in the interest of the candidates concerned to immediately contact the respective Regional Offices of the Commission in all such cases where they do not belong to the category shown against their Roll Numbers.
