NOTIFICATION

It is for information of all concerned that the recruitment to the posts of Junior Information and Public Relation Officer (advt. no.03/2018 dated 28.2.2018) and Senior Information and Public Relation Officer (advt no.06/2018 dated 17.3.2018) under the Information & Public Relations Department, will be held in 3(three) phases, *viz.*, (i) Screening Test, (ii) written examination, and (iii) viva-voce interview. The detail scheme of test/exam is given below:

(1) Screening Test (ST):

- (i) OMR based ST will be conducted to short-list the candidates for the written examination, consisting of 100 marks (100 objective type questions) with 2 hours duration.
- (ii) Only those candidates who qualify in the Screening Test will be eligible for appearing in the written examination.
- (ii) The Syllabus for the ST is given at **Annexure-I**.

(2) Written examination:

- (i) The written examination (conventional essay type) will consist of one paper carrying 200 marks with 3(three) hours duration.
- (ii) The paper for the written examination will be in two parts (i) **Part-I**: English consisting of (a) Essay, (b) Comprehension, (c) Report writing on any given issue and (ii) **Part-II**: On topic of Mass Communication & Journalism and General Awareness.
- (3) **Viva-voce interview:** The viva-voce interview shall carry **25 marks**.
- (4) The merit of the candidates will be based on **225** marks. (Written exam:200 marks, Viva-voce:25 marks)
- (5) The details schedule of programme for holding ST, written examination, etc. will be notified later on.
