Declaration of Final Result of
Combined Higher Secondary (10+2) Level Examination, 2011

1. The Staff Selection Commission conducted Combined Higher Secondary (10+2) Level Examination, 2011. The written result was declared on 25-01-2012.

2. Details of the skill tests are given below.:-

3. While allocating posts of DEO and LDC to the qualified candidates, merit-cum-order of preference criteria has been adopted. Order of preference for these posts exercised by candidates while applying for the examination and their option for Preferences (L for LDC, D OR E for DEO), Groups (X, Y) for LDC, Pref. of Services/Deptt./Cadre for 'DEO' and 'LDC', preferences for states exercised in the application duly verified by Regional offices as received from concerned regional offices in soft copy of Verified data have been considered. All the vacancies reported for the post of Data Entry Operators have been clubbed under option D and candidate's preferences for both D and or E have been considered for allocation against these vacancies, as vacancies have been reported for post of DEO with grade pay of Rs. 2400 only.

4. Candidates who have not exercised preference for any of the preferences fields, group, pref. of services/deptt./cadre/state have not been considered for concerned posts/groups/cadres/States as per policy of the Commission. Allocation lists have been prepared keeping in view the number of vacancies reported by the User departments. While allocating States/cadres to candidates within group of posts, sub-options given by them have been used.

5. After allocation of candidates as per their merit cum preference as detailed above, 1 vacancy of DEO remained vacant. Hence, one candidate has been selected for this post in merit order with default preference. The rank given to this lone candidate is RL/1 and he will be en-bloc junior to candidates selected in the select list with SL ranks.

6. Category wise break-up of the candidates selected for DEO (Preferences D and E) and LDC (Preference L) is given below. Vacancies reported from some states for the post of Store keeper have been included in the vacancies of LDC in Y Group:-

7. Criteria for resolving tie cases : (Tie-cases have been resolved by applying following criteria, one after another, as applicable till the Tie is resolved) :-

- (i) Total marks in the written examination.
- (ii) Date of Birth, with older candidate placed higher.
- (iii) Alphabetical order in which the first names of the candidates appear.
- (iv) Alphabetical order in which the other names of the candidates appear.

8. Number of vacancies available, Candidates recommended and marks obtained by the first and last selected candidates for the post of DEO and LDC preference wise and state wise are given below. Rows corresponding to post/ state/ category with nil reported vacancies have not been included in the tables. If all the reported vacancies against a category (9-UR, 1-SC, 2-ST, 6-OBC) have been filled by candidates selected against horizontal categories (3-ExS, 4-OH, 5-HH, 7-VH), Lowest and Highest marks are shown against the horizontal category only and corresponding fields against the vertical categories are 0 :-

9. For the post of DEO, 1 candidate whose candidature has been kept as provisional by concerned Regional Offices is also included in the Select list. Concerned RDs/DDs will check the eligibility of such candidate thoroughly before nomination.

10. The above said List are **purely provisional** and subject to the recommended candidates fulfilling all the eligibility conditions prescribed for the respective post in the Notice of Examination and also subject to thorough verification of their identity with reference to their photographs, signatures, handwritings, etc., on the application forms, admission certificates, etc. The candidature of the candidates are liable to be cancelled by respective Regional Directors in case candidates found not fulfilling the eligibility conditions or any other genuine reasons.

11. For candidates belonging to reserved categories for whom certain percentage of vacancies are reserved as per Government Policy, the category status is indicated against their Roll Numbers. It is important to note that some of these candidates have been declared qualified only for the category mentioned against their Roll Numbers. If any candidate does not actually belong to the category mentioned against his/her name, he/she may not be eligible to be included in the list. It is, therefore, in the interest of the candidates concerned to immediately contact the respective Regional Office of the Commission in all such cases where they do not belong to the category shown against their Roll Numbers.

12. There are some candidates who are qualified in DEST, but have been shown as exempted from TT by Regional Offices. These candidates shall not be nominated before specific approval of the Commission.
