LIVE YOUR DREAMS - JOIN THE ELITE

1. Applications are invited from unmarried male candidates for grant of Short Service Commission (SSC) in Executive Branch (Sports) in the Indian Navy for Jun 2013 Course at Indian Naval Academy (INA) Ezhimala, Kerala. Candidates to fulfill conditions of nationality as laid down by the Government of India.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

2. **Age.** 22 to 27 years, born between **02 Jul 1986** and **01 Jul 1991**; both dates inclusive.
3. **Educational Qualifications.** Regular, First Class Post Graduate Degree in Physical Education, from a recognised university together with Diploma in Sports Coaching from National Institute of Sports (NIS) or MSc in Sports (Coaching). Candidates with M Phil and Phd will be given priority during shortlisting for SSB.

Note:- Candidates who have not completed their Post Graduation (i.e. appearing candidates) need not apply, their application will not be accepted.

4. **Sports Qualifications.** A candidate should have participated in an All India Inter University Championship or Senior Level National Championship/ Games in following disciplines:-

(a) Athletics (b) Cross Country (c) Triathlon (d) Badminton (e) Tennis (f) Squash/ Football/ Handball/ Hockey/ Basketball/ Volleyball/ Cricket/ Swimming/ Diving/ Water Polo/ Kabaddi/ Boxing.

5. Physical Standards.

(a) **Height and Weight.** Minimum height - 157 cms with correlated weight.
(b) **Eye Sight.** The minimum acceptable vision standard for distant vision 6/12, 6/12 correctable to 6/6, 6/6 with glasses. Should not be colour/night blind.
(c) There will be no relaxation in physical standard.

SHORT SERVICE COMMISSION

6. Short Service Commission is granted for a term of 10 years, extendable to 14 years in steps of 02 years each i.e., 10+2+2., subject to service requirement and performance/ willingness of the candidate. No extension beyond 14 years and no option for Permanent Commission in future would be granted. On completion of these tenures, officers are entitled for gratuity under the extant rules. Disciplined life, leadership qualities and professional skills imbibed during the service would stand as added advantages in acquiring second career post exit from the Navy.

HOW TO APPLY

7. (a) If you meet the above requirements, apply on plain A4 size paper (typed or handwritten) in the prescribed format and complete in all respects with superscription on the envelope "**APPLICATION FOR SSC (SPORTS) - Jun 2013 COURSE Qualification..... Percentage.....%**" are to be sent to the address given below by **24 Dec 2012**. Applications sent by Speed Post/Registered Post/Courier will not be accepted.

(b) Application must be sent in the format given in the advertisement, otherwise it will be rejected.

(c) Application must be accompanied by **attested copies** of:- (i) 10th Standard Certificate for verification of date of birth, (ii) other educational certificates, (iii) Marks statement of all semesters/years.

(d) Application and requisite enclosures must be properly tagged/stitched by thread only. Integrated Headquarters Ministry of Defence (Navy) will not be responsible for loss of enclosures, if sent loose.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

8. (a) Shortlisted candidates will be called for preliminary interview at New Delhi. No rail fare or allowance will be admissible to candidates attending the preliminary interview at New Delhi. Candidates qualifying the preliminary interview will be detailed for Service Selection Board (SSB) at Bhopal, Bangalore or Coimbatore followed by a medical examination.

(b) SSB interviews for short listed candidates will be scheduled during Mar to Apr 2013.

(c) SSB interview will be conducted in two Stages. Stage I test consisting of intelligence test, Picture Perception and Discussion test will be conducted on the second day of arrival at SSB. Candidates who fail to qualify in Stage I will be routed back on the same day. Stage II tests comprising of Psychological testing, Group testing and Interview will last for 04 days. Successful candidates will thereafter undergo Medical Examination (approx duration 03-05 days).

(d) Candidates recommended by the SSB and declared medically fit will be appointed for training as per all India Merit depending on the number of vacancies.

(e) Change of SSB Centre for interview is not permissible under any circumstance.

(f) Any correspondence regarding change of SSB dates be addressed to the call up officer of the SSB on receipt of call up letter.

(g) No compensation will be paid in respect of any injury sustained as a result of tests.

(h) AC 3 tier rail fare is admissible for the SSB interview, if appearing for the first time for this commission.

TRAINING

9. The training is scheduled to commence in the month of **Jun 2013**.

10. Candidates will be inducted as officers in the rank of Sub Lieutenant and undergo Naval Orientation Course at the Indian Naval Academy, Ezhimala, Kerala followed by professional training at various Naval Training Establishments/Units/Ships. Full pay and allowances are admissible to officers whilst under training. They will be on probation for a period of two years, during which they are liable to be discharged if their performance is unsatisfactory.

11. Only unmarried candidates are eligible to undergo training. Any candidate who is found to be married or marries while under training will be discharged and shall be liable to refund full pay & allowances drawn by him and other expenditure incurred on him by the Government.

12. Life in Navy is full of challenges and adventures. Navy provides some of the finest training facilities, which will turn you in to a skilled professional, mentally agile and physically fit officer.

DUTIES OF SPORTS OFFICER

13. Physical Training Officers at various establishments. Secretary/Assistant Secretaries at INSCB/INSCCs where he would have to look after various facets of sports management. Sports Officers at Command Headquarters/establishment. Any other sports related duties that he may be called upon to perform.

THE NAVY OFFERS YOU

14. Promotions & Pay Scale: Promotion from Sub-Lieutenant to Commander is on time scale basis subject to fulfillment of requisite service conditions. The Pay Scale and promotion criteria are as follows:-

15. Allowances (as applicable). The rates of allowances applicable to officers are as follows:-

16. **Sports & Adventure.** The Navy provides facilities to pursue any sport of your liking. In addition, one can learn and participate in adventure sports, such as river rafting, mountaineering, hot air ballooning, hang gliding, wind surfing etc.

17. **Physical Fitness.** In Naval Academy curriculum, a lot of emphasis is laid on physical fitness. You are therefore, advised to remain fit by undertaking regular physical exercises, sports, running, swimming, etc. so that you meet the training goals successfully.

18. **Cost to Company (CTC).** The CTC for a Sub Lieutenant would be approximately Rs. 66500/- per month. This includes Basic Pay, DA, Grade Pay, Military Service Pay, House Rent Allowance and Transport allowance. These rates are subject to change.

19. **Privileges.** In addition to the CTC mentioned above, Navy provides free Medical Facilities for self & dependents, Canteen Facilities, Entitled Ration, Mess/Club/Sports Facilities, Furnished Govt. Accommodation, Car/Housing Loan at subsidised rate.

20. **Group Insurance & Gratuity.** Insurance cover of 40 lakhs for Executive (GS) (on contribution) and Gratuity will be granted to the officer as per the latest rules in force.

21. **Leave Entitlements.** On Commission, officers are entitled to 60 days annual and 20 days casual leave every year (subject to service exigencies). They are also entitled for 40% rail concession to any place and free travel (as per extant rules) for self and dependents. Leave during training period will be as per the Training Policy in force.
