	PGT-(Computer Sc.)	M.Sc. in Computer Science or MCA/BE/B.Tech in Computer Science or M.Sc. with PGDCA. Teaching qualification not essential.
2	TGT (English)	BA with English as main subject and B.Ed. from a recognized University.
3	TGT (Social Science)	BA with any two of the following subjects: History, Geography, Economics and Political Science of which one must be either History or Geography.
4	TGT (Hindi/Skt.)	BA with Hindi and Sanskrit and B.Ed. from recognized University
5	TGT (Chem./Bio.)	A bachelor's degree with Chemistry, Botany and Zoology and B.Ed. from a recognized University.
6	TGT (Maths./Phy.)	B.Sc. with Maths and Physics and B.Ed. from a recognized University.
7	TGT (Computer Sc.)	B.E. in Computer Engineering / Science OR BCA / B.Sc. with Computer Science/IT OR Graduate Degree in Science with 'A' level Diploma from DOEACC OR Class XII with 3 yr Diploma in Computer Science/Computer Engineering
8	TGT - PET (Female & Male)	B.P.Ed of 3 yrs duration OR BA/B.Sc with P.B.Ed. OR 1 year B.Ed. with Physical Education. Distinguished sportsmen who have represented the country in recognized National or International events may also be deemed eligible for appointment if they possess a university degree. The condition of possessing a diploma in Physical Education or equivalent qualification shall not apply in their case.
9	TGT (Art)	Class X with 4/5 yr Diploma in Art or OR Class XII with 3 year Diploma in Art OR BFA OR BA with Drawing and Painting as main Subjects. Desirable: Working knowledge of computer application. Teaching Qualification not essential.
10	PRT (EMS)	(a) Class XII with English, Hindi, Maths, Science and Social Science / BA/B.Sc. (b) JBT/D.Ed. after XII or B.E.L.Ed/B.Ed. <i>Note: Commerce candidates need not apply.</i>
11	PRT (Music)	B.A. in Music or equivalent or Class XII with Sangeet Visharad from Gandharv Mahavidyalaya, Mumbai or equivalent. Teaching Qualification not essential.

INFORMATION FOR ALL POSTS:

- i) M.A.Ed. / M.Sc.Ed./ B.A.Ed./ B.Sc.Ed. from NIE with desired subjects are also eligible, *for TGT Posts pass in Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) conducted by CBSE*.
- ii) Qualifying Degree / Diploma should be from a recognized university with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks. English as subject in class XII is mandatory for all posts.
- iii) Teaching qualification must be B.Ed. or equivalent degree from a recognized university wherever required.
- iv) Competence to teach the concerned subject through English medium is required. Proficiency in Hindi is desirable.
- v) Teaching Experience in an English Medium School/ College and knowledge of Computer Applications are desirable.
- vi) Candidates whose examinations results are awaited may also apply. They will be considered, if selected, subject to submitting proof of acquiring desired qualifications at the time of interview.
- vii) The reservation of vacancies for SC, ST, OBC, Minorities and Physically and Visually challenged candidates will be as per the rules of the Government of India.

Teaching Experience : Experience is desirable for all the posts .

Upper age limit may be relaxed in case of meritorious candidates with teaching experience at the discretion of the interview board.

The candidates securing minimum 50% marks for General Category and 45% marks for Reserved Category in written test only will be eligible for interview.

Normally preference will be given to candidates with teaching qualifications (B.Ed.). However, if the performance of a candidate without a B.Ed. is found to be exceptionally good with consistently good academic record she/he may be considered for appointment.
