Equivalence for Ph.D. is based on publication of 5 International Journal papers, each Journal having a cumulative impact index of not less than 2.0, with incumbent as the main author and all 5 publications being in the authors area of specialization.
2. Ph. D shall be from a recognized University.
3. For an incumbent Assistant Professor, experience at the level of Assistant Professor will be considered equivalent to experience at the level of Associate Professor, provided incumbent Assistant Professor has acquired or acquires Ph. D degree in the relevant discipline.
4. Experience at Diploma Institutions is also considered equivalent to experience in degree level Institutions at appropriate level and as applicable. However, qualifications as above shall be mandatory.
5. As per U.G.C. Regulations, for the post of Professor (Mathematics) : An outstanding professional with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/ allied/ relevant discipline to be substantiated by credentials are also eligible.
