# RECRUITMENT FOR THE POST OF DY. JUDGE ATTORNEY GENERAL (DY. COMMANDANT) ITBPF.

Application are invited from Indian Citizens for filling up 11 posts of Deputy Judge Attorney General (Deputy Commandant) (Group-A, Gazetted Non Ministerial Combatised Post) in the PB-3 of Rs. 15600-39100/- plus Grade pay of Rs. 6600/- in ITBPF (MHA) Govt. of India. On joining the organization, selected candidates will be governed by ITBPF Act 1992 and ITBPF Rules 1994 as amended from time to time and are liable to serve anywhere in Union of India or outside. The posts being in combatised stream of the Force, the officers selected will have to wear the rank and badges of the post as per Govt. of India orders/ instructions.

- 2. The candidates who will be called for interview are entitled to traveling expenses as per provisions contained in Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India OM No. F-190145/1/74-E.IV(B) dated 30-1-76 (Govt. of decision No. 5 & 08 below SR-132) i.e. ordinary bus fare or single 2<sup>nd</sup> class rail fare chargeable by passenger train by the shortest route from the railway station nearest to the normal place of residence or from where they actually perform the journey whichever is nearer to the place of interview and is in excess of 250 Kms for both outward and return journey. However, in the case of candidates belonging to SC/ST communities, 2<sup>nd</sup> class rail fare or bus fare shall be payable to the candidates provided the fare of the first 30 Kms for both outward and return journey is born by the candidate. In both the cases, it will be subject to production of certificate of non-employment in Government service from an MP or MLA or Gazetted Officer; of the place where he is residing.
- 3. <u>Concession/ Allowances:-</u> In addition to above scale of Pay, DA, HRA and Transport allowance wherever admissible, as per Government order and rates will also be payable. The applicants will also be entitled to the following concessions/allowances:-

- (v) Special duty allowance at 121/2% of pay when posted in the North-East including Sikkim & Leh.
- (vi) Initial uniform grant of Rs.14000/- (in two installments). Renewal uniform grant of Rs.3000/- after every 3 years and kit maintenance as the prescribed rate.
- 4. <u>Eligibility conditions:</u> The candidates applying for the post must fulfill the following conditions of eligibility:-
- Age: (i) Not exceeding 35 years as on closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalya, Arunchal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of J&K State, Lahual & Spiti Distt. and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba Distt of Himachal Pradesh, The Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands or Union Territory of Lakshadweep).
  - ii) Age limit is relaxable upto a maximum of five years in the case of Government servants in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Government from time to time. Also relaxable upto 05 years in case of SC/ST candidates and three years for OBC categories in accordance with the orders of the Central Government from time to time. The age relexation is also admissible to the ECOs/SSCOs as per GOI, Deptt of Pers & Trg. O.M. No.39016/15/79-Estt(C) dated 7<sup>th</sup> September, 1981 and O.M. No. 36034/8/88-Estt(SCT) dated 19<sup>th</sup> May, 1988.

## Part-II: Written Examination:-

Important:- The candidate must not have knock-knees, flat foot or squint in eyes and they should possess high-grade colour vision. The candidates will be tested for colour vision by Ishihara's test as well as Edrich Green's Lantern tests. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

Candidates should be in good physical and mental state for duties in high altitude and to serve in border areas with extreme climatic conditions. Every candidate on having been selected will be produced before constituted Medical Examination Board for examination of his Medical fitness. The said Medical Board will issue Medical Examination report of the candidate in the prescribed form. ## 10. Conditions of service:-

(i) Candidates shall be required to serve in the Force for a minimum period of 10 years. If any officer after joining the service wants to resign from the service before the expiry of 10 years, he is required to refund a sum equal to three months pay and allowances attached to the post or the cost of training imparted to him by the Force, whichever is higher.
