The walk-in interview will be held on January 30, 2014 at 10:00 a.m in the Committee Room, 1st Floor, Zakir Hussain Block, NCERT. The minimum qualifications are as under:

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR in Theatre (Rs. 35,000 consolidated)

Essential Qualification:

- A
- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in Theatre from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited Indian/ foreign university.
 - ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates should have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
 - iii At least two years experience of working in a school.

OR

- B. An outstanding professional, with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/ allied/ relevant discipline, will be preferred.

Desired Qualifications

Experience in working/conducting workshops with teacher educators, teachers and students of schools.

A degree/diploma in Education

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR in Dance (Rs. 35,000 consolidated)

Essential Qualification:

- A
- i. Good academic record with at least 55% of the marks, or an equivalent grade to that of 55% wherever grading system is practiced at the Master's degree level, in the relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian/Foreign University.

- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates should have cleared the National Eligibility test (NET) conducted by the UGC, or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iii. At least two years of working in a school.

OR

A traditional - professional artist with professional achievement in the concerned subject, who should have:

1. Studied under noted/reputed traditional masters and has thorough knowledge to explain the subject concerned.
2. B high grade artist of AIR/TV.
3. Ability to explain the logical reasoning of the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in that discipline.

Desired Qualifications

Experience in working/ conducting workshops with teacher educators, teachers and students of schools.

A degree/diploma in Education
