Stenographer Grade (C&D) Examination, 2013
Declaration of Written Result to call the candidates
for Skill Test

Staff Selection Commission conducted the Stenographer Grade (C&D) Examination, 2013 on **29.12.2013** at various centres all over the country. As per available information/records **2,75,810 candidates** appeared in this examination.

2. Following are the lists of **2462 & 23945** candidates in Roll Number order declared **provisionally** qualified in the written part of the examination for Skill Tests for the post of Stenographer **Grade ‘C’ and ‘D’** respectively subject to their fulfilling all eligibility conditions and also correctness of the information/options furnished by them in their applications. The cut-off fixed and availability of candidates under different categories is as under :

List- I: Candidates qualified for Skill Test for Steno Grade “C”

Note: Category/preference for the 2 posts (Group C, Group D) has been taken from data received from the Regional Offices. Candidates with ‘Blank’/Invalid post preference were considered for both posts, subject to policy of the Commission in this regard.

3. The results are **provisional** and subject to the recommended candidates fulfilling all the eligibility conditions prescribed for the respective post in the Notice of Examination and also subject to thorough verification of their identity with reference to their photographs, signatures, handwritings, etc., on the application

forms, admission certificates, etc. The candidature of the candidates liable to be cancelled by respective Regional Directors in case candidates found not fulfilling the eligibility conditions or any other genuine reasons.

4. **No candidate has been rejected/awarded 'zero' marks on the ground of wrong coding of Ticket No. on their OMR answer sheet. Further, only those candidates who have not correctly coded first three digits from left hand side of their Test Form No., have been rejected/awarded 'zero' marks.**

5. For candidates belonging to reserved categories for whom certain percentage of vacancies are reserved as per Government Policy, the category status is indicated against their Roll Numbers. It is important to note that some of these candidates have been declared qualified only for the category mentioned against their Roll Numbers. If any candidate does not actually belong to the category mentioned against his/her name, he/she may not be eligible to be included in the list. It is, therefore, in the interest of the candidates concerned to immediately contact the respective Regional Office of the Commission in all such cases where they do not belong to the category shown against their Roll Numbers.

6. The Skill Test are scheduled to commence tentatively from **10.06.2014**. For programme of individual regional offices of the Commission, candidates are advised to follow concerned regional office website. In this connection the following points are brought to the notice of the candidates.

Skill Test in Stenography :

- a) The matter will have to be transcribed on computer only.
- b) The Skill Test would be qualifying in nature. The candidates will have to appear for the stenography test. The candidates will be given one dictation for 10 minutes in English/Hindi at the Speed of 100 w.p.m. for the post of Stenographer Grade 'C' and 80 w.p.m. for the post of Stenographer Grade 'D'. The time for transcription on the computer is as under:

For Stenographer Grade 'C'	English – 40 minutes
	Hindi - 55 minutes
For Stenographer Grade 'D'	English - 50 minutes
	Hindi -65 minutes

- c) There is no exemption from Skill Test for any category of candidate.
- d) If the candidates had not indicated the medium of Stenography Test at relevant place in the application form, the Commission will consider English as the medium of Stenography Test for such candidates and candidates will not be allowed to change the medium at subsequent stage.

- e) VH candidates will be required to transcribe the matter in 75 minutes for English Shorthand or in 100 minutes for Hindi Shorthand for the post of Stenographer Grade 'D' and in 70 minutes for English Shorthand test and in 95 minutes for Hindi Shorthand test for the post of Stenographer Grade 'C'.
- f) The Skill Test will be held at Commission's Regional/Sub-Regional Offices or at other centres as may be decided by the Commission. Candidates are advised to go through instructions on the Skill Test available in candidate's corner in Commission's website. Their specific attention is drawn to keyboard lay-outs and fonts used in Skill Test in Hindi.
