QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED (ASSISTANT TEACHER)

1. <u>ESSENTIAL</u>:-

Senior Secondary (OR its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-years Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known) from a recognized Board.

Or

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 45% marks and 2-years Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known) in accordance with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) regulation 2002.

Or

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 years Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.).

Or

Graduation and two years Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known) from a recognized Board.

- **2.** Pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).
- **3.** Must have passed Hindi as a subject at Secondary Level.

Note.1: Relaxation up to 5% in the qualifying marks shall be allowed to the candidates belonging to reserved categories such as SC/ST/OBC/PH.

Note.2: Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Competent Authority, for reasons to be recorded in writing in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

- **4. Desirable :** Computer Knowledge
- **5.** Age limit for Direct Recruitment : Not Exceeding 30 years.

Note 1: (Relaxable for Government Servants up to 5 years in accordance with the instructions / orders issued by the Central Government

Note 2: The crucial date for determining the age-limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura Sikkim, Ladhakh Division of J & K State, Iahul and Spiti Districts and Pangi Sub-division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh & Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshaweep).
