- (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/ college, and/ or experience in research at the University/ National level institutions/ industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- (iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process.
- (iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS). [ To be submitted in separate format (amended) as prescribed under Appendix –III Table-I (Category I,II, & III) of the UGC (2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment) Regulations 2013 published vide No. F.1-2/2009 (EC/PS) V (i) Vol- II dt. 13.6.2013 ]
- N.B :- The provisions under clause 6.1.0 & 6.0.2 as well as the Table-I (category I,II,III) of Appendix-III prescribed in the UGC Regulation 2010 have been amended in the above cited 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment .

**Reader.**

- i. Good academic record with a Ph. D. Degree in the concerned/ allied/ relevant disciplines.
- ii. Acharya / Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- iii. A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/ research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor/ Lecturer in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry excluding the period of Ph. D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- iv. Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
- v. A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS). The application form sent/submitted by any other mode will not be accepted. The application form received after due date will not be entertained.


**General Information & Instruction :**

1. The application form duly filled in by the candidate must be supported by attested copies of all certificates, mark sheets, evidence of teaching, research experience and production of Ph. D. scholar(s), copies of published articles, certificate containing the record of date of birth. **The required proforma for API as per UGC (2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment ) Regulation 2013 is appended herewith .**
2. Candidates are required to attend the interview on their own expenses.
3. Candidates are required to produce their original certificates/testimonials for verification at the time of interview.
4. ST/SC/SEBC candidates must furnish the original Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority for verification.
5. Applications of the in-service candidates should be routed through the concerned employer. However advance copies may be sent directly to save delay subject to the production of no objection certificate at the time of interview .
6. A relaxation of 5% will be allowed from 55% to 50% of the marks at the Master's Level for the SC/ST / PWD categories .
7. Candidates who have obtained 55% or more marks or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 Point scale as mentioned below in the Master's Degree should only apply except in the case of SC/ST candidates .


