

Result of LGC posts likely to be announced soon

The long wait of thousands of candidates who appeared for exam followed by typing test for the posts of Lower Grade Clerk (LGC) is likely to be over soon. According to the Dy. Secretary (Personnel), A&N Administration, Mrs. Krishna Chakraborty, the results of the LGC posts are ready and will be published after the Lt. Governor gave his approval. However, she was not sure how long it will take. "I don't know when the result will be published. It is under submission to the Lt. Governor," the Dy. Secretary said refusing to give any dateline for the declaration of result.

But indications are that the result would be out sooner than later as the Lt. Governor is widely known not to keep anything pending at his end.

The A&N Administration had conducted a written examination (Phase-I) on 9th Nov, 2014 to fill up 302 vacancies of Lower Grade Clerk under the category UR (General), OBC reserved, ST, Persons with disability, Meritorious Sports persons and Local Ex-Servicemen.

A total 21,999 candidates were eligible for the written examination. On 12th Feb, 2016, the result of written exam was declared and 1746 candidates cleared the exam. Then the typing test (Phase-II) for 1746 candidates was conducted by the Administration with the assistance of Staff Selection Commission, New Delhi at Port Blair in April 2016.

It is almost four months but the result has not yet been declared. The candidates are gradually losing their patience as their fate hangs in balance. But now their long wait is likely to end very soon.
