

RECL skill development project inaugurated to train youths for jobs

Vyasan R, IAS, Additional Secretary, Planning & Coordination department, Government of Nagaland inaugurated the skill development project sponsored by Rural Electrification Corporation Limited (RECL), a Government of India enterprise, at Pinnacle Skills training centre in Dimapur on July 27.

The project has been organized by RECL in association with National Skill Development Corporation and will be executed by Pinnacle Skills. Under this project over 500 youths will be trained in courses like Hospitality, Retail, Helper electrician and Data entry operator.
