1. Eligibility :-

In order to be eligible for engagement, a candidate must satisfy the following conditions.

- (a) He/She must be a citizen of India.
- (b) (i) He/She must have passed the High School-Certificate or an equivalent or any higher examination with Odia as a language subject, or
(ii) He/She must have Odia as a medium of examination in non-language subject at the High School Certificate or equivalent examination, which He/She have passed.
- (c) Candidates having bachelor degree in Arts / Commerce / Science with Bachelor degree in Education from any universities of the State or its equivalency are eligible. Regarding Universities / Institutions of outside State, the candidates shall only be eligible for engagement after verification of genuiness of their educational / training qualification from concerned university/ institutions from which they have obtained the degree

- (d) Such outside university / institution candidates shall have to produce the authenticated proof of equivalency and NCTE recognition in support of their qualification at the time of verification failing which they will not be eligible in the selection process.
- (e) The case of PH candidates shall be referred to Appellate Medical Board constituted by the W&CD Department vide Notification No. 16430/WCD Date 06.09.2011 for re-examination. Engagement order shall be issued if such candidates are found genuine by the Board.

2. Age :

Candidates shall be under **32 years** of age and above **21 years** of age as on **01.01.2016**. However in case of SC / ST, Women, SEBC, ex-military persons the Upper age shall be relaxed by 5 years and incase of PH candidates the upper age shall be relaxed by 10 years. This is done in conformity with G.A. Deptt Notification No. 33068/Gen. Dtd. 27.10.1989 (Odisha Civil Service, fixation of Upper age limit Rules, 1989) and SEBC Act.

3. Educational Qualification :

- (A) **B.A. B.Ed. Teacher** – He / She must have obtained bachelor degree in Arts / Commerce (with two school subjects) from a recognized university with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) along with a degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university. He/She must have passed OTET.

OR

He / She must have obtained bachelor degree in Arts / Commerce (with two school subjects) from a recognized university with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) along with a degree in Bachelor in Education (One year B.Ed. Special Education with RCI Registration Certificate) from a institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university. He/She must have passed OTET.

- (B) **B.Sc. B.Ed. Teacher** – He/She must have obtained bachelor degree in Science (PCM/CBZ) (with two school subjects) from a recognized university with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) along with a degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university. He/She must have passed OTET.

OR

He/She must have obtained bachelor degree in Science (PCM/CBZ) (with two school subjects) from a recognized university with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) and a degree in Bachelor in Education (One year B.Ed. Special Education with RCI Registration Certificate) from a institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university. He/She must have passed OTET.

(C) **Sanskrit Teacher** – Bachelors Degree with Sanskrit as one of the optional / Hons subject from a recognized university with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) with Sikshaya Shastri (Sanskrit) (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a recognized university / institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university or Shastri (Sanskrit) with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) from recognized university and Sikshaya Shastri (Sanskrit) (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a recognized university / Institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university.

OR

Acharya (Except Jyotishacharya and Ayurvedacharya) or Sahityacharya with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognized university.

OR

Bachelor's degree with Sanskrit as one of the optional / Hons subject with minimum 50% of marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) and M.A. in Sanskrit with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognized University. **(The untrained candidates shall have to undergo required training within the timeline as prescribed by Govt.)**

(D) **Hindi Teacher** – Bachelor's degree from a recognized University with Hindi as one of the elective subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) or with Rastrabhasa Ratna from Rastrabhasa Prachar Samiti, Wardha or with Sastri from Orissa Rastrabhasa Parisada, Puri or with Snataka (Acquired by June 2005, the date up to which the temporary recognition has been granted) from Hindi Sikshya Samiti, Orissa, Cuttack or an equivalent degree from a recognized institution with at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) and Hindi Sikshyan Parangat from Kendriya Hindi Sansthan, Agra/B.H.Ed. (a course prescribed by NCTE) from Dakhin Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha, Madras, a institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university.

OR

Bachelor's degree with Hindi as one of the optional / Hons subject with minimum 50% of marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) and M.A. in Hindi with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognized University.

(The untrained candidates shall have to undergo required training within the timeline as prescribed by Govt.)

(E) **PET** : +2 or its equivalent examination with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/SEBC candidates) and CPED from recognized Board / University.

OR

Degree / Post Graduate Degree in Physical Education i.e. B.P.Ed. / M.P.Ed. a (course prescribed by NCTE) from a recognized University / Institution.

(To ensure that untrained candidates will get the training within the stipulated period, minimum percentage of marks is prescribed as per the guidelines of NCTE).

- (F) **Junior Clerk** : He/She must be passed +2 examination or it's equivalent from a Recognised Institution with having basic knowledge in Computer.
- (G) **Peon** : He/She must be passed 7th Class or it's equivalent.
- (H) **Science Attendant** : He/She must be passed 7th Class or it's equivalent.


4. **Remuneration** : Remuneration will be allowed as per the instruction of Govt. of Odisha from time to time.

The B.Ed./B.H.Ed./Sikshya Sashtri candidates should have registered their names either in the employment Bureau located at Vanivihar, Bhubaneswar / Jyoti Vihar, Sambalpur / Bhanja Vihar, Berhampur / OUAT, Bhubaneswar or in the State Employment Exchange, Bhubaneswar or at in any district employment exchange. The candidates for PET/Urdu/Classical/Hindi teachers should have registered their names in the employment exchange located in the concerned Revenue District which he/she belongs to /State Employment Exchange.
