

Chittoor district collector says AP generate about 80,000 jobs in the next three years

Siddharth Jain says district is likely generate about 80,000 jobs in the next three years

Poised to emerge into an industrial hub, the Chittoor district will be generating about 80,000 jobs in the coming three years, maintained District Skill Development Committee Chairman and District Collector Siddharth Jain.

Speaking during the maiden meeting of the District Skill Development Committee, conducted at Sri Venkateswara University's (SVU) Senate Hall here on Thursday, Mr. Jain along with participants from education, industry, banking and other sectors, reviewed the developmental activities to be carried out and arrive at a roadmap to make the youth job-ready by imparting training, skill development and awareness on latest technologies.

Mr. Jain remarked that in the next three years, about 90 companies/industries would be established in the district, giving a major boost to employment opportunities in the region.

He said that universities should host a separate facility to conduct skill development training programmes.
