Indian Army to hold recruitment drive in Goa from November 9 to 11

PANAJI: The Indian Army will carry out a recruitment rally for all categories, including soldier general duty (GD), soldier technical, soldier clerk/store keeper, soldier technical (nursing assistant) and soldier tradesmen, from November 9 to November 11 at 3 Technical Training Regiment ground, Bambolim. The recruitment rally, to be conducted by the Kolhapur army recruiting officer, is exclusively for Goan candidates.

The age criteria for soldier general duty is 17.5 to 21 years as on October 1, 2016, while candidates applying for any other category will have to be between 17.5 to 22 years as on October 1, 2016.

The qualification for soldier general duty is SSLC or matriculation with 45% marks as aggregate and 33% in each subject. Those applying for soldier technical should have cleared 10+2 or the intermediate exam in science with physics, chemistry, maths and English and should score 50% marks as aggregate and 40% marks in each subject.

For the post of soldier clerk, candidates should have passed 10+2 or intermediate exam in any stream arts, commerce or science with 50% marks as aggregate and a minimum of 40% in each subject.

The qualification required for soldier technical (nursing assistant) is 10+2 or intermediate exam clearance in science with physics, chemistry, biology and English. A minimum of 50% marks should be obtained as aggregate and a minimum of 40% in each subject. In case the candidate has a BSc in botany, zoology or bio-science and English, the stipulated percentage required at the Class XII level will be waived off.

Those applying for the post of soldier tradesman should have passed Class X or ITI.

Candidates should bring their certificates and documents in original, along with two photocopies of all documents duly attested by a gazetted officer. They should also carry the admit card that is generated after online registration and application through the Army's website.
