

SSC CHSL exam 2015: Check revised pattern, new stage introduced

SSC CHSL 2015: The Staff Selection Commission (SSC), in a notification, has informed that they have added one more level in the Combined Higher Secondary Level (CHSL) examination 2015.

Earlier, after the declaration of tier 1 exam, shortlisted candidates were called for skill test for data entry operator and for the typing test of LDC. But now between these two levels, a new stage has been introduced (tier 2) where the qualifying candidate has to appear for the essay and letter / application writing.

This means from now, the SSC will conduct three levels of CHSL examination – tier 1 will be descriptive, tier 2 will test essay and letter / application writing skills while tier 3 of the examination would continue to be the skill test / typing test which would be of a qualifying nature.

The final merit of the successful candidates would be calculated on the basis of total score obtained by them in Tier 1 and Tier 2.

Exam pattern of CHSL 2015 Tier 2 paper

The paper would comprise writing of an essay of 200-250 words and letter / application writing of approximately 150-200 words.

The duration of the paper would be for one hour

The minimum qualifying marks would be 33 per cent. The performance in Tier 2 would be included for preparing merit.

The paper will have to be written either in Hindi or in English.

The skill test / typing test will be held immediately after the tier 2 exam. The specific dates for the same would be uploaded on the official website of the Commission and the regional offices.

The result for Tier 1 is already out and Tier 2 will be conducted tentatively on September 18, 2016.

The Combined Higher Secondary Level Examination, 2015 was held on November, December, 2015 and July, 2016.
