### **SSC CHSL result 2015: Candidature of 5,792 aspirants cancelled**

SSC CHSL 2015 result: The Staff Selection Commission had declared the results of the Combined Higher Secondary Level (CHSL) exam Paper – 1 2015 on July 29. But as per a new notification, the Commission has informed that after analysing the result, they have found 5792 candidates had appeared in the examination twice and therefore, their candidature has been cancelled.

Out of these 5792, 334 candidates had qualified in the examination and their results were kept in abeyance while evaluation of 253 aspirants was not done.

Therefore, the SSC has decided to cancel the candidature of all the 5,792 candidates (including the 334 and 253 candidates mentioned above) for their having appeared more than once in the CHSL, 2015 examination.

The CHSL exam was held on November 1, 15, 22, and December 6, 2015, at various examination centres across the country. As many as 30,44,455 candidates took the exam in 2015.

Note: At the time of the conduct of Tier-II (descriptive paper) of CHSL, 2015, the candidates would have to give an undertaking that they have appeared in the Tier-I exam of CHSL, 2015 only once.

The SSC had released a notification for 6,000 vacancies in July 2015 for postal assistant and sorting assistant (3,523 posts), lower divisional clerk (2,049 posts) and data entry operator (1,006 posts). Read: SSC CHSL 2015 exam: Results declared

The recruitment examination has a written test. Once candidates pass the written prelims and mains examinations, they will be called for a skill test and an interview round. To download the results, candidates need to take the following steps.

The Staff Selection Commission was officially active with effect from September 4, 1977 to conduct recruitment exams for various government Departments and Subordinate Offices. The SSC is responsible for conducting Class – III (Group – C) examinations for non-technical posts in these offices.
