Portal for 'Backward Class Job Mela'

VIJAYAWADA: In a good news for members of the Backward Classes, the state government on Thursday launched an exclusive website for organising a 'job mela'. Details of vacancies in various private companies will be posted on the portal to enable BC candidates to apply for the same.

Launching the website here, BC welfare minister Kollu Ravindra said the portal would be in the public domain. So far, 13 companies have notified 1,048 vacancies through the website, he added.

Stating that the government would organise a 'job mela' of BC candidates at Rajahmundry on October 15, Ravindra said so far 78 BC students were given financial assistance to pursue higher studies abroad under the AP NTR Videshi Vidyadarana Scheme. Besides, coaching is being offered to 750 Civil Services aspirants and 650 candidates seeking to join banking services, he said.
