Teacher's recruitment to be conducted by APPSC: Ngandam

ITANAGAR, Aug 9: Education Minister Honchun Ngandam has said that future recruitment of teachers will be handed over to the Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Commission. He said this while interacting with officers of his department including the Secretary Education Bidol Tayeng in Itanagar.

The officers briefed him about the complaints and grievances of the candidates appearing the ongoing Teachers Recruitment Exam being conducted by Education department.

The minister has directed the officers to look into the complaint of the candidates which includes wrong setting of questions papers, if any and to take suitable action for giving advantage to the candidates against setting of wrong questions and answers.

Earlier, Honchuun Ngandam inspected the two centres to see the ongoing examination for recruitment of teachers. Accompanied by Jairampur MLA Laisam Simai, Secy Tayeng, Director secondary Education Gania Leij, the minister inspected Govt Higher Secondary, Itanagar and Govt Middle ESS Sector, Itanagar.

The department of education is conducting the examination for 224 posts for recruitment of TGT and PGT. About 4 thousand candidates from different districts of the state are appearing the examination.
