

Chandigarh Municipal Corporation demands filling of 606 vacant posts

The municipal corporation has written to the UT administration demanding filling of 606 vacant posts and stated that work is suffering owing to manpower shortage in the civic body.

In the letter to the Secretary Urban Local Bodies, municipal joint commissioner Virender Chaudhary has mentioned details of the posts lying vacant in the civic body.

It was mentioned in the letter that all the posts have been lying vacant for more than one year. “These posts are lying vacant for more than one year under the direct recruitment quota. The municipal corporation is responsible for providing basic infrastructure in the city. The municipal corporation has a huge shortage of manpower owing to which work is suffering,” the joint commissioner stated in the latter, adding that filling of the posts is urgently required with the civic body recently implementing the Citizens Charter.
