Jobs promised for differently abled

The government will take steps to ensure that differently abled individuals will get employment in eligible posts, Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan has said.

He said that only a small proportion of candidates was now being considered for employment. School managements, especially, were not considering differently abled people for postings, he said.

‘Prepare database’

He was speaking after inaugurating the distribution of tri-scooters for the differently abled under the ‘Sneham’ project of the district panchayat.

“We have to give special care to differently abled children. They are talented in several areas. We have to find these areas and nurture their talent. The district panchayat should prepare a database of differently abled children. We have to find them if they are getting special care and training. The local bodies have a huge role to play in this,” said the Chief Minister.
