Quality jobs for ITI students to be ensured

The government will take steps to ensure that students passing out of the women's industrial training institute (ITI) at Kazhakuttam get quality jobs, Minister for Labour T.P. Ramakrishnan has said.

He was speaking after inaugurating a new building of the ITI, a computer lab, dormitory, and laying the foundation stone of a hostel there.

He said only nine of the 19 trades taught here had National Council on Vocational Training recognition. Efforts would be made to do away with hurdles in the path of recognition to others. If any changes were to be introduced in the trades, the government would consider that too. He directed officials to provide job-oriented training to students.
