Candidates selected for interviews can apply for re-scheduling of dates

Indore : The Madhya Pradesh Public Service Commission (MPPSC) has decided to re-schedule interviews of state civil service examination-2014 for those candidates whose interview dates are clashing with dates of civil service main exam-2016.

The decision came following complaints lodged by some candidates that their interviews dates are coinciding with that of dates of 2016 civil service main exams scheduled from October 1 to 7.

In a notice, the MPPSC said that candidates who had cracked 2014 main exams and were selected for interviews may have been aggrieved by 2016 main exams.

“All those candidates whose interview dates are clashing with 2016 main exam dates should file an application with the MPPSC requesting for change in their interview dates,” the notice reads.

“The candidates will have to submit a proof for clashing of dates by producing copies of 2016 exam’s admit cards and interview letters,” the notice adds.

Many candidates, who are to appear in interviews for 2014 exam, which are currently underway and continue till October 26, are also taking 2016 main exam which is to be held from October 1 to 7.

The MPPSC said that interviews of aggrieved candidates will be re-scheduled after October 26.
