

MPPEB to hold online test for over 9 lakh applicants

Setting a benchmark in online examination provision, Madhya Pradesh Professional Examination Board (MPPEB), earlier known as Vyapam, is all set to hold online test for 9,24,000 applicants in three different shifts.

To hold the exam in a disciplined way, 75,000 candidates would be called in a day to write the exam. All provisions for the same have been made. The board would organise test for constable category on July 17 for which over 9 lakh candidates have applied. According to PEB, a team under guidance of Deepak Khandekar, chairman and director Bhaskar Lakshakar have taken responsibility for the same. The board officials said special vigilance is being kept for this exam. All the district collectors and police superintendents have been directed to maintain law and order during this exam.

Sensitive and super sensitive centers would be installed with jammer three days before starting the exam. None of the candidates will be allowed to use any kind of electronic device. The board has also made provision of Rs 1,00,000 reward for person informing about unfair means or cheating cases at centers. The board directed that examinees should carry photo identity voter ID card, pan card, driving license, marksheet, bank passbook, passport and other authorised proof.
