Over 6.9 lakh labourers on rural job scheme: Maharashtra govt

MUMBAI: The Maharashtra government says that the rural job guarantee scheme in the state is currently employing 6.9 labourers in the state. As many as 40,443 works are currently on.

Also, with the onset of the monsoon, the number of cattle camps set up in the drought-hit belt has reduced. At the peak of the drought, there were 400 cattle camps operating in the state. The number has now reduced to just 46. There is one camp in Beed, 4 in Osmanabad, 35 in Ahmednagar and one in Sangli and Parbhani.
