Paul bats for ‘no interviews at junior level’

SHILLONG: West Shillong legislator, Paul Lyngdoh has petitioned Chief Minister Mukul Sangma urging him to effect the discontinuation of interviews at junior level and non executive posts in the State Government.

The demand from the MLA comes following the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions’ decision to do away with interviews for junior level posts in Central Government offices. Lyngdoh, in the memorandum, stated the State government should implement the same in toto and effect the discontinuation of interviews at junior level and non executive posts.

According to Lyngdoh, it is high time the State Government attracts the best possible manpower which can only be done if the Government succeeds in dismantling all forms of favoritism and nepotism in bodies like the Meghalaya Public Service Commission and district selection committees.
