Sericulture Dept could provide a lot of employment opportunities

Governor V Shanmuganathan on Friday administered oath of office and secrecy to two newly-inducted ministers, Ronnie V Lyngdoh and Martin M Danggo at the Raj Bhavan in Shillong.

The two Cabinet ministers were inducted into the Congress-led Meghalaya United Alliance (MUA)–II government after Rowell Lyngdoh and A L Hek were dropped as deputy chief minister and health minister respectively.
