BJP Yuva Morcha meets Odisha Guv, Demands cancellation of ASO test result

Bhubaneswar: Taking up the job seekers' cause in the state, BJP Yuva Morcha activists met Odisha Governor SC Zamir on Saturday and submitted a memorandum to cancel the results of recently held Assistant Section Officer (ASO) test. The morcha is alleging widespread irregularity in the recruitment test.

According to reports, a group of BJP Yuva Morcha activists led by General Secretary Thakur Ranjit Das met Zamir Saturday morning and held a discussion with the Governor. During their discussion with Zamir the team tried to convey the him that, the recruitment test for ASO conducted by Odisha Public Service Commission (OPSC) does not seem to be an transparent one and hence the result of it should stand cancelled.

Demanding his intervention in the matter, the morcha members claimed that, the examination was not conducted in an unbiased manner at all as some students at several of the ASO test centres were given extra time to finish their papers. They said some invigilators on examination duty extended undue assistance to their near and dear ones appearing the test. Similarly, the morcha members also alleged that, all the test centres of ASO did not start the examination simultaneously facilitating the leak of the question papers. Among others, the OPSC's inability to put up answer sets of the ASO question papers on its website, and failure in announcing cut-off marks for different categories were the other points which were raised by the morcha members.

Among others, BJP Yuva Morcha Secretary Om Prakash Mishra, Deepak Gochhayat, Biswaranjan Jena, Bikash Panigrahi, Debasish Nayak, Pradosh Kumar Parida, Satya Ranjan Tarai and Srikant Pradhan also present during the submission of the memorandum.
