

Jobs for wards of govt employees

PUDUCHERRY: Chief minister V Narayanasamy presented appointment orders to 78 wards of deceased government employees of health and family welfare department on compassionate grounds on August 1.

The health and family welfare directorate identified vacant posts in Puducherry (61), Karaikal (12), Mahe (3) and Yanam (2) following direction from Narayanasamy to fill them up on compassionate grounds.

The posts of cleaner cum stretcher (4), field worker (17), lab assistant grade II (2), lab attendant (14), laundry attendant (11), men servant, women servant and filarial inspector (1 each), health sanitary workers (20), table matti servant (2) and theatre attendant (5) were vacant.

The directorate also screened the wards of the deceased employees and allotted them suitable posts.

Narayanasamy presented them appointment orders in the presence of secretary (health) B R Babu, director (health and family welfare services) K V Raman and officer on special duty (health) B Zareena Begam and other officials.
