Vacancies to be filled on compassionate grounds: Puducherry CM

Following Chief Minister V. Narayanasamy's instructions to fill up all the vacant posts in Government Departments, the Directorate of Health and Family Welfare Services, has launched measures to fill up the vacancies on compassionate grounds.

The vacancies of posts in Puducherry, Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam regions of Health Department were identified and 78 dependents of the deceased/invalidated Government employees of the Health Department given jobs.

The Chief Minister, accompanied by Education Minister R. Kamalakannan, Health Director K.V. Raman and B.R. Babu, Health Secretary, handed over appointment letters to the beneficiaries.

The break-up of the posts in categories such as Field worker, lab assistant-Grade II, lab attendant, Filaria Inspector and sanitary worker (health) are 61 in Puducherry, 12 in Karaikal, three in Mahe and two posts in Yanam.
