Govt issued orders to fill vacancies of teachers

Puducherry: Puducherry government proposes to introduce e-governance facility following a directive from the Union government, said chief minister V Narayanasamy.

Speaking after launching a new website, 'collectorate.py.gov.in' of the Puducherry district collectorate in the presence of revenue minister M O H F Shahjahan, health minister Malladi Krishna Rao and Puducherry collegector Satyendra Singh Dursawat, Narayanasamy said the Union government has directed the Puducherry government to allocate three percent of the budget for launching e-governance facility.

He said the website will help the residents to apply for all documents including encumbrance ertificates and land records. He added that the government will soon set up common service centres in Puducherry town, Villianur, Bahour and Tirukanur and the residents can obtain all certificates from these centres.

He warned of stringent action against government employees, who reach office late. He later issued appointment orders to 130 people recruited on contract basis under the National rural health mission. He also issued appointment orders to 44 physical education teachers selected through direct recruitment for filling up the vacant posts in various government schools in Puducherry in the presence of agriculture minister R Kamalakannan and secretary (education) S Sundaravadivelu.
