389 recruited in Punjab Police

The result of Police Recruitment Test conducted by Punjab Government ahead of the Assembly elections was declared today. As many as 42.65 per cent candidates managed to clear the exams and got inducted in the Punjab Police.

As per the figures provided by the police, of the 1,196 candidates called, only 389 managed to get selected. As many as 19 of them were found under the influence of drugs and were declared positive for the substance abuse test (SAT).

Those who appeared for the test numbered 912 and 520 of them failed to get through the tests. Physical fitness played a major role in clearing the exam which was conducted in the presence of senior police functionaries and experts at the Police Lines, Bathinda.

Of the total candidates, 434 failed to clear the physical tests. Sixty-seven failed to meet the height benchmark. The case of three candidates is pending.
