SBI PO Mains exam 2016: Result postponed to August 20



SBI PO Mains result 2016: The State Bank of India (SBI) has postponed the release the result of the Mains examination for the recruitment of Probationary Officers (PO) to August 20. The result was previously scheduled to be released today, August 16.

The online examination was conducted on July 31, 2016. The candidates can check the result on sbi.co.in.

The application process for the SBI PO vacancy had started on May 4, 2016 and ended on May 24, 2016. Those candidates who will pass the main exam will be called for the interview round and only after clearing all the three rounds, the post will be awarded to the candidates.

State Bank of India conducts these examinations on an annual basis to fill vacancies at its banks across the country. The bank had earlier released a notification PO (CRPD/PO/2016-17/02) to recruit eligible candidates for 2,260 posts of probationary officers.
