MDMK urged the govt to fill vacancies in Govt Hospitals in Tiruvannamalai district

The MDMK has urged the State government not to cut the trees as part of the 'girivalam' path widening project. A resolution was adopted at a meeting held here on Sunday where MDMK general secretary Vaiko participated.

The resolution insisted on implementation of the project without cutting the trees, without causing damage to herbs, plants and animals living in the forest area and brooks that bring water to the ponds located along the 'girivalam' path.

Another resolution urged the government to waive all loans availed of by farmers and students. Other resolutions insisted on introducing direct trains between Tiruvannamalai and Chennai, Tiruvannamalai and the Southern districts; bus services for government arts colleges in Cheyyar, Tiruvannamalai and University Engineering College, Arani, and Government Polytechnic in Karapattu near Tiruvannamalai; and filling of vacancies in government hospitals in Tiruvannamalai district.
