

10 year age relaxation for one more year likely in Telangana

Hyderabad: The 10-year age relaxation for candidates appearing for Telangana government jobs may get extended for one more year.

The state government has prepared a draft in this regard and sent it for Chief Minister K Chandrashekhara Rao's approval.

Considering the fact that there was no recruitment during the past 10 years, the Telangana government has relaxed maximum age limit for 10 years and issued a GO:329 on July 27, 2015.

With an objective of providing employment opportunities for the youth, the Telangana government has taken this decision in up the age limit from 34 years to 44 years. This is applicable for those who belong to BC, SC, ST and physically-challenged categories. The GO is also applicable for the all posts announced by Telangana State Public Service Commission (TSPSC) and other recruitment departments. The GO is expiring on July 27, 2016.

Few posts in some departments have been filled during the past one year. TSPSC is expected to notify for job recruitments in the days to come. Several organization representing unemployed have made an appeal to the Telangana government to extend the age limit relaxation so that it would benefit many.

As per the law, age relaxation extension has one year time limit. Hence, Telangana government may also take a positive decision on age relaxation by extending one more year.
