Minister helps youth fined for Telangana slogan get job

A youngster from Ranga Reddy district, A. Srikanth Reddy, who got selected for police constable post but denied order for being imposed fine in a case relating to pro-Telangana agitation, got the job with the initiative of Home Minister Nayani Narsimha Reddy.

The youngster from Ranga Reddy district was selected for the post of stipendiary cadet trainee police constable (civil) in 2008 but was not issued order since he was involved in a case. Mr. Reddy raised 'Jai Telangana' slogan during a public meeting addressed by the then Chief Minister of erstwhile united Andhra Pradesh, K. Rosaiah, in 2010 at Yacharam of RR district. A case was registered against him and a fine amount imposed. On this ground, orders were not issued to him though he had been provisionally selected for the post. Mr. Reddy had been representing to the Telangana State Government to issue orders for his post. He took up the matter with the Police Recruitment Board and got a GO finalising his selection.
