

Recruitment of Veterinary Doctors soon: Srinivas Yadav

Hyderabad: CM of Telangana State, Mr. K. Chandrasekhara Rao has sanctioned vacancies of Veterinary Doctors in the Dept. of Animal Husbandry. In view of this, steps have already been started to fill up the vacant posts. This was disclosed by Minister of Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development, Mr. T.
