Zonal system to stay for government recruitments

HYDERABAD: Much to the relief of the youth preparing for government jobs like Group I, Group II, teacher's posts and others, the government has decided to conduct competitive examinations whose notifications have already been issued, under the existing zonal system, without any changes.

The Telangana government has already issued a notification for Group II and other posts and more than 10 lakh candidates have applied. However, the government's decision to scrap the existing zonal system and introduce a new system of district-level and state-level posts raised doubts over competitive examinations in the state.

But a clarity on the zonal system dawned after TSPSC chairman Ghanta Chakrapani met chief minister K Chandrasekhara Rao on Wednesday. "It was decided to complete the recruitment under the existing zonal system," Chakrapani said.
