MP HC orders State Govt to fill Vacant Posts in Govt Engg Colleges

Jabalpur: Madhya Pradesh high court on Tuesday directed the state government to fill all the vacant posts at the government engineering colleges in six months.

Division bench of high court comprising justice Rajendra Menon and Justice Anurag Shrivastav issued the order while hearing a petition regarding the vacant posts in five government engineering colleges of the state. Petitioner Manish Sharma of volunteer organisation Nagrik Upbhokta Margdarshak Manch informed the court that 343 posts of principal, lecturer, and assistant lecturers are lying vacant at five government engineering colleges of the state.

Sharma also said in his petition that due to these vacancies the studies in the government-owned engineering colleges are being affected and the students of these colleges are bearing the brunt of it. State government, in its reply, told court that the process to fill these posts has already started. Court disposed the petition ordering that all these posts should be filled up within six months.
