

MPPSC State engineering service prelims on August 20, 21

Indore : State engineering service preliminary exams would be conducted by Madhya Pradesh Public Service Commission (MPPSC) on August 20 and 21.

Commission on Tuesday released notification of the preliminary exams for 278 assistant engineer's posts lying vacant in five government departments including urban development and environment, public works, water conservation, public health engineering and panchayat and rural development departments.

Candidates can apply online for the exams from June 20 to July 20. Correction in online application forms, if any, can be done from June 30 to July 22 at a cost of Rs 50. MPPSC secretary Manohar Dubey said that the exams would be held in computer-based mode at centres in seven cities including Indore, Bhopal, Gwalior, Jabalpur, Ujjain, Sagar and Satna.

The MPPSC would release separate notification for main exams. Selection process of engineering services is a three-stage process. In the first two stages, exams are conducted and in the third stage interviews are held of candidates declared qualified in the main exams
