TELANGANA GOVERNMENT TO RECRUIT 489 VETERINARY ASSISTANTS

Hyderabad: Telangana government has approved recruitment plan of 489 veterinary assistants in Animal Husbandry Department.

Finance Department Secretary N Shiva Shankar on Thursday issued orders for the recruitment.

The responsibilities of Veterinary Assistant include assisting Graduate Veterinarians in veterinary institutions such as veterinary dispensary, veterinary hospitals and veterinary polyclinics. Veterinary Assistant will also conduct vaccination for livestock, deworming sheep and goat. Veterinary Assistants participate in campaigns, primary sector mission programs under guidance of Graduate Veterinarians.

Meanwhile, Telangana State Public Service Commission (TSPSC) has made all the necessary arrangements for Grade-2 Agriculture Extension Officer exam to be held on Saturday (4 June) as 7,645 candidates are appearing for this online exam, said Parvati Subramanian, Secretary, TSPSC, in a statement. The state government has made transport facility for the candidates as RTC will run special buses on the day. Candidates are advised to reach exam centers well in advance.
