Qualification & Experience

Essential:

 i) Post graduate degree (MD) with one year R & D/Teaching Experience or Postgraduate diploma in medical subjects with two years R & D/Teaching experience in the required subject from recognized university.

OR

Date: 08/07/2017

ii) MBBS degree recognized by MCI or equivalent degree from recognized University with 4 (four) years R & D/Teaching experience in the relevant subject after MBBS Degree.

Desirable:

- i) MD in Microbiology/Pediatrics from a recognized university for candidates with MBBS or equivalent degree.
- ii) Additional Post-doctoral research/teaching experience preferably in Microbiology/virology in recognized institute(s).
- iii) Knowledge of Computer Applications or Business Intelligence tools/Data Management

Notes:

- i) MD degree in relevant subjects shall be treated equivalent to three years' experience respectively.
- ii) Post graduate diploma in medical subject in the relevant subject shall be treated equivalent two years experience.

Job Requirement:

The Incumbent is expected to lead the research project team and should have the capability to formulate, execute and interpret scientific research work on Enteroviruses. The candidate should be willing for both field and clinic based work. The incumbent is also expected to have a good knowledge on the application of epidemiological tools in diagnosis, control of enteric communicable diseases and software like Epi-info, SPSS, etc. The incumbent should be willing to get involved in the training of Post Graduate students in the field of Public Health Viral Diseases, evaluation of Public Health Programmes and Epidemic Investigation in collaboration with the respective State Health Department. The incumbent should be prepared to carry out field investigation anywhere in India.

Age:

- 1. Not exceeding 40 years.
- Upper age limit is relaxable to SC/ST/OBC and Govt.
 Servants as per provision made in Health Research
 Scientist Cadre (HRSC) of of ICMR Rules 2007.
- 3. One time age relaxation is allowed to Scientific and Technical Staff working in long term projects in ICMR Institute/Centres provided they meet the essential qualifications and experiences for the post with a view to provide them an opportunity to compete with other candidates as per provisions made under HRSC rule 2007 vide Council's letter No.6/1/2007 –Admin II dated 28.3.2011

General Relaxation Clause:

Age, qualification and experience will be relaxable in deserving cases as mentioned in the Recruitment Rules of Health Research Scientists Cadre of ICMR, 2007 under Rule 14 and Note 1&2 of Schedule-III.

Other Services Conditions:

- 1) Pay & Allowances admissible as per DOPT Guidelines
- 2) Private practice is not allowed, however, non-practicing allowance is admissible to Medical Graduate as per rules
- 3) Pension will be admissible as per new restructured defined contributory pension system contained in the Ministry of Finance; Department of Economic Affairs (ECD & PR Division), Notification No. 5/7/2003-ECD & PR dated 22/12/2003 effective from 01.01.2004.

- 4) Applications from employees working in Central/State Govt. / Public Section undertaking and Govt. funded research agencies must be forwarded through proper channel. Advance copies of application will be considered subject to the condition that a "No Objection Certificate" from the employer is produced with the application or at the time of personal discussion. Application received after the closing date will not be considered.
- 5) The post carry all India transfer liability.

Selection Procedure:

A Written examination (objective type) of the eligible candidates will be taken. Candidates will be called for personal discussion/interview on the basis of merit in written examination. The final selection will be as per criteria adopted by the ICMR.

- 3) Documents to be enclosed with the application form (self_attested copies):
 - a) Proof of Date of Birth
 - b) Educational qualification
 - c) Experience
 - d) List of Publications mentioning clearly the 'Name of the Journal' and Ímpact Factor'
 - e) Community certificate (OBC)
 - f) Crossed Indian Postal Order (IPO) / Demand Draft for Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) payable to the Director-in-Charge, Enterovirus Research Centre. SC/ST/ Women and Person with disabilities candidates are exempted from the application fee. IPOs/DDs are payable by all other candidates including ICMR employees. Indian Scientists working abroad are exempted from application fee.
 - g) Caste Certificate
 - h) Persons with disabilities certificate (If applicable)
- 4) Unsigned/Incomplete application in respect of the above points or application without supportive evidence asked for or applications without payment challan copy and applications received after the prescribed closing date are liable to be summarily rejected.

Note:

- a) No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates for appearing in the written test exam.
- b) Outstation Candidates called for personal interview will be paid 2nd class rail fare by the shortest route on production of documents.
- c) Any canvassing by or on behalf of the candidates or to bring political or other outside influence with regard to selection/recruitment shall be disqualification.
- d) Since it is not possible to call all the eligible candidates for the written test /personal discussion, the applicants will be short-listed for this purpose.
- e) The decision of the Director General, ICMR will be final in this regard.

Important Note:

- i) SC/ST and person with disabilities candidates should submit attested copies of certificates for claiming fee concession/age relaxation.
- ii) OBC certificate for the purpose of age relaxation will mean "PERSONS OF OBC CATEGORY NOT BELONING TO CREAMY LAYER" as defined in DOPT'S O.M. NO. 36012/22/93-Estt (SCT) dated 8.9.1993 and modified vide O.M. NO.36033/3/2004-Estt (Res) dated 9.3.2004 and 14.10.2008. The closing date for receipt of application will be treated as the date of reckoning for OBC status of the candidate and also for assuming that the candidate does not fall in the Creamy layer on the reckoning date. The candidate should furnish the relevant OBC certificate in the format prescribed for Govt. Job and furnish declaration. OBC candidates must therefore furnish valid and updated OBC certificate which should specifically include the clause regarding Exclusion from Creamy Layer' in order to get age relaxation.
